Purpose of Position	As a member of the Tearmann Society for Abused Women governing body, you are responsible for the overall guidance of the Society and ensuring Tearmann Society's mission is maintained.

Length of Appointment	<p>3-year term</p> <p>The board of directors meets once a month (except for the months of December, July & August) for approximately 1.5 hours. Additional time may be required for committee work (approx.3-4 hours a month).</p>
